

HIGHLIGTS – APRIL

- In average, at the analyzed ports/hubs, the IPP for Diesel was positive (Arb open) practically every day of the month, reaching R\$0.00/L in the Import Parity Prices (IPP).
- In average, at the analyzed ports/hubs, the IPP for Gasoline was negative (Arb closed) during almost the entire month, reaching –R\$0.24/L below of Import Parity Prices (IPP).
- The price of Brent, heating oil (diesel oil) and RBOB (gasoline) opened the month at a high level, experiencing a slight reaching a peak, followed by a strong reduction from the middle of the month.
- The exchange rate (FX) continues to pressure internal prices, at levels above R\$4.90/US\$ during the month, reaching a peak of R\$5.08/US\$ and closing the month at R\$5.00/US\$.
- ➤ Sea Freight, Gulf of Mexico to Southeast Brazil, had strong fluctuations in the month, opened the month at 45 US\$/m³, reaching a peak of 52 US\$/m³ and followed by a sharp reduction, closing the month at 31 US\$/m³.
- ➤ The Renewable Volume Obligation (RVO) discounts were stable variation from 0.1844 US\$/GAL to 0.1927 US\$/GAL.


DAYS WITH ARB OPEN OR CLOSED - DIESEL OIL - APRIL



➤ Above Import Parity Prices (IPP) also considers AT PAR days.




DAYS WITH ARB OPEN OR CLOSED - GASOLINE - APRIL



➤ Above Import Parity Prices (IPP) also considers AT PAR days.




- Maximum Lag of -R\$ 0.24/L on April 8th.

GASOLINE (RBOB) PRICES




- Maximum Price of ≈ 2.68 US\$/gal on April 11th.
